At the beginning of the holiday season, we held our online holiday auction. Thanks to our generous donors, we had an amazing collection of over 150 items for bidders to choose from. Through this event, we were able to raise \$13,400. We can't wait to bring this event back next year!



We would like to thank the Cardinal Volleyball Team from Necedah Area School District for supporting Mile Bluff patients by hosting a Pink Night Game in October. During the game, the team raised \$648.01 to benefit our cancer care patients. Their contribution will be used to purchase wigs, scarves, and other items for patients undergoing chemotherapy.



In October, VARC held its second annual Breast Cancer Awareness Walk and choose to raise funds for cancer care patients at Mile Bluff. The clients and staff did a wonderful job, and raised \$1,590 for patients.



APPROVED EQUIPMENT REQUESTS

Through the generosity of donors, Mile Bluff Medical Center Foundation is able to provide financial support to the medical center to purchase needed equipment. After department directors submitted requests, and after careful review, in October 2024 the foundation's board of directions approved \$16,952 in equipment purchases.

BOVIE LED PROCEDURE LIGHT - \$4,772

Awarded to: Elroy Family Medical Center

This light will be used during in-clinic procedures. Whatever the procedure, this lamp is easier for staff to maneuver, which leaves caregivers with more time for addressing the patient's needs.



EZ WAY MECHANICAL LIFT - \$4,493

Awarded to: Crest View Nursing & Rehabilitation Center

This lift will be used at Crest View to transfer residents from different surfaces such as the bed, chair, toilet and floor. It improves safety for residents and staff alike.

AV500 VEIN VIEWER - \$4,129

Awarded to: Infusion & Wound Care

Used on a daily basis, the vein viewer is a tool that supports successful IV starts in minimal attempts by allowing nurses to view veins when starting a peripheral IV. It also allows staff to assess for valves within the vein to avoid hitting them on IV starts.

VITALS CART - \$1,606

Awarded to: Long-term Care Rehabilitation Services

Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy staff caring for residents at Fair View, will use the vitals cart with a resident prior to starting a therapy session. The cart would also be readily accessible if a resident starts to experience an emergency event.

2 - IBREEZE BPAP SYSTEM - \$1,482

Awarded to: Respiratory Therapy

The iBreeze BPAP system is a bedside unit that delivers positive airway pressure therapy for the treatment of obstructive sleep apnea and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. This unit will be used on patients that have already been diagnosed and use this type of device at home, but did not bring it with during a hospital stay.



DIGITAL PEDIATRIC SCALE - \$470

Awarded to: Mile Bluff Clinic

This digital scale will be used for pediatric patients. It will make the rooming process for young patients easier and will ensure weights for children are accurate.

Jos You. With You. A Capital Campaign Update


If you've driven by the Gateway Center lately, you would hardly know that it was once a Shopko building. As evident by the new signage and finished exteriors, you can tell that Gateway is nearing completion.

Internally, finishing touches are being installed in all of the patient care areas. Some flooring still needs to be completed, and a few HVAC adjustments must be made before Gateway can undergo an occupancy inspection. Once Mile Bluff receives the green light, the building will undergo a thorough deep clean, and departments will begin moving to the new space in phases.. Be on the lookout for information regarding the community open house that will be held before the building opens for care.

Once the departments, and patients, are settled in at the Gateway Center, the next phase of this expansion project will begin in the Emergency Department (ED). At this time, Mile Bluff's administrative team is working with the project architects to review and revise the ED plans. One of the biggest challenges is planning how to provide emergency care while in a construction zone.

To support this project, Mile Bluff Medical Center Foundation has been leading a capital fundraising campaign – *For You. With You.* – with the goal of raising \$5 million to offset construction costs. In 2024, donors were very generous and the year ended with \$2.49 million being given toward this initiative.

LOCAL COUPLE DONATES \$25,000 TO MILE BLUFF'S CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Mile Bluff Medical Center Foundation has received a \$25,000 donation from local residents and business owners, Jeff and Melanie Gray, to support Mile Bluff's Gateway Center and Emergency Department expansion project.

When Jeff and Melanie learned about this expansion project, they saw that the plans would support the growing healthcare needs of Juneau County residents and visitors. "When people have good access to healthcare, they are more likely to receive the care they need to live long, healthy lives," said Melanie Gray. "With easy access, people are encouraged to receive regular check-ups and timely treatment, preventing minor health issues from escalating into more serious conditions. Having healthcare services available locally, helps our community be healthier and more productive."

Mile Bluff has been transforming the former Mauston Shopko building as part of a two-phased expansion project. Now referred to as the 'Gateway Center,' the 26,000-square foot building will serve as the new location for Mile Bluff's Mauston dialysis unit, urgent care clinic, and retail pharmacy. Once urgent care services are relocated, Mile Bluff will embark on the second phase of this \$17.5 million building project by remodeling the current Emergency Department. These new spaces will improve efficiency, accessibility, privacy, safety and the overall experience for both patients and staff members.

To support this expansion initiative, Mile Bluff Medical Center Foundation is leading a capital fundraising campaign – For You. With You. – with the goal of raising \$5 million. The campaign is an opportunity for individuals and businesses, like the Grays, to help strengthen local healthcare for the community.
